3-D Printer Policy

3-D printers are being used for educational, workshop and programming purposes to make three-dimensional objects using a design uploaded from a digital computer file. The Library's 3-D printers may be used by the public subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Use of a 3-D printer is limited to Ferguson Library library cardholders who are 8 years of age or older. Users under the age of 10 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 2. Prior to his or her initial use of a 3-D printer, an individual must submit to prescribed orientation by a library staff member or volunteer.
- 3. Users of the 3-D printer are responsible for their own safety and must sign a Waiver of Liability in favor of the Library before their first use of the printer. A copy of the Waiver of Liability form is attached to this Policy.
- 4. Print sessions are generally limited to 2 hours. Users can request extended usage under special circumstances. Decisions regarding such requests are at the sole discretion of staff.
- 5. At present, there is no charge for use of the 3-D printer.
- 6. The Library's 3-D printers may be used only for lawful purposes. Users are not permitted to use the printers to create material that is:
 - Prohibited by local, state or federal law.
 - Unsafe, harmful, dangerous, poses an immediate threat to the well-being of others or that is otherwise inappropriate for a library environment.
 - In violation of another's intellectual property rights.
